

WIND RIVER ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION SWIMMING POOL RULES

The following rules are established to promote enjoyment of the pool by all Association Members of Wind River Estates HOA and to support a fun, safe and healthy environment for our neighborhood:

- Hours are 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (unless closed for maintenance) Police will be notified if there are people in the pool area outside the normal hours.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY - For your own safety, no one should swim alone
- In case of emergency dial 911
- Association Members ONLY with maximum two (2) guests per household
- Absolutely NO SMOKING inside the fenced in area of the pool. The pool area has been designated as a NO SMOKING area.
- No eating or drinking in the water. All trash and food in pool area must be picked up.
- Running in pool area is prohibited
- Diving, including running dives, is prohibited
- Disorderly conduct, profanity or other offensive behavior will not be tolerated. Police may be notified by any Association Member encountering this unfortunate behavior.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for actions of their family and visitors using the pool
- Children under 16 years and under must be accompanied by an adult who is an Association Member
- Children 8 years and under must have direct adult supervision by an Association Member
- Absolutely no diapers in pool or shallow pool, non-potty trained children must wear watertight pants when using the pool - Pool contamination will result in pool closure for a minimum of 24 Hours for disinfecting.
- No person with open sores, abrasions, or skin disease may use the pool
- No person with nasal or ear discharge or communicable disease
- No pets, rollerblades, skateboards, or bicycles, etc. inside fenced pool area
- Glass containers are prohibited in pool area
- Cigarette butts and trash must be disposed of in proper receptacles
- Gates must remain closed and latched at all times, if a person wants in and does not have a key DO NOT let them in unless you absolutely have knowledge that they are an Association Member.

Use of the pool is contingent upon payment of Association Dues and abiding by pool rules. In the case of a lost or stolen key, a written request, along with payment of \$25.00 will be required prior to issue of a new key.
